
Workshop Structure:

All of our KS1 and KS2 workshops are **half day sessions**, which last around 1hr 45mins - 2hrs, **unless otherwise specified**. However, you can mix and match any 2 sessions for a full day visit (10am-2.15pm). EYFS sessions last approximately 1hr.

EYFS 1 hr Workshop

What is it like to visit a castle? Take part in range of themed, age appropriate activities, from dancing in the Throne Room and playing with toys, to sitting round the Bishop's dining table and creating your own craft to take home.

KS1
History

Explore all the things that make Auckland Castle a castle in our fun, interactive tour of this interesting historical building and its grounds, before making a 3D model to take home.

Knights and Bishops

KS1 & KS2 History

Who lived in a castle like this? Hear the story of how the Prince Bishops came to be, handle real and replica artefacts, attend Bishop Barrington's Ball, go to dinner with Bishop Trevor and take part in real knight's training.*

*KS1 and lower KS2 only - students in upper KS2 will have the opportunity to become archaeologists as they explore some of Auckland Castle's hidden treasures.

Tom McGuinness Arts Award

KS1 & KS2 - Full Day Only **Art and Design, History**

Complete a Discover Arts Award in a day! Learn all about Tom McGuinness, explore the Mining Art Gallery and create your own print based on McGuinness' artwork. The children will fill out a logbook throughout the day. Each child will receive an Arts Award certificate for completing the project.

Please note Arts Award sessions are at an additional cost of £4.70 per child.

Bevin Boys and World War Two

KS2 Art and Design, History, English

Uncover the history of the 'forgotten conscripts' - the Bevin Boys. See real artwork made by Bevin Boys such as Tom McGuinness and Ted Holloway. Discover why coal was so important during World War Two, see real objects and explore the stories of those who spent the war underground - in their own words.

Len Tabner and Watercolours

KS2 - October 2023 to April 2024 Art, History

Explore our temporary exhibition by mining artist Len Tabner. Create your own landscape watercolour masterpiece inspired by Tabner to take home with you.


Find out about life in mining communities during the 20th century, as you explore our range of mining artworks and examine our historical handling collection.
